

Everyone is welcome at Skive Public Library

At Skive Public Library you can borrow books, movies, games and music. You can participate in and experience events and workshops – or you can simply drop by to sit and read, play or talk to friends and neighbors. Below are some good advice and a guide to how you can use the library.

Do you wish to borrow books or other media?

- The staff at the infopoint on the ground floor, right by the main entrance, can help you register as a library user. If you own a yellow health insurance card with your CPR number on it, you need to bring it with you.
- When you register as a library user you need to choose a personal code. You will need this code whenever you borrow books or other media or if you need to access the library during the unattended opening hours.

Do you wish to attend an event?

- The library offers a variety of events and activities for children as well as adults. An understanding of the Danish language is required at most events, but we do occasionally offer events, concerts and workshops where everyone has a chance to enjoy and get creative.
- Some events are free but might still require you to sign up in order to reserve a spot, as seating may be limited. Tickets in general can be reserved or bought through the library's website: www.Skivebibliotek.dk (the website is in Danish) or it may be reserved or bought from the staff at the infopoint on the ground floor.

Does it cost anything to use the library?

- Generally, the library and its services are free to use, but you do have to pay a small amount if you wish to copy or print documents. It is also possible to buy a cup of coffee or hot cocoa in one of our two vending machines located on the ground floor and second floor. If you have any doubts or concerns, just ask the staff. We are happy to help.
- If you do not return or renew your borrowed materials by the end of your loan period (usually 28 days if nothing else is stated), you will have to pay a fee.

Do you wish to copy, print or scan?

• It is possible to copy, print and scan at the library. The staff can help you. It is free to use the scanner, but it costs a small amount to copy and print.

Opening hours

The library is open every day from 7 am to 10 pm. In the morning and in the evening the library is unattended, but you can still use the library. During the unattended hours you can let yourself in using your personal code, if you are a registered user of the library and over the age of 15.

Below is an overview of when it is possible to get assistance from the library staff:

- Monday Thursday: 9 am to 6 pm
- Friday: 9 am to 5 pm
- Saturday: 10 am to 1 pm
- Sunday(from October through feb.): 1 pm to 4 pm
